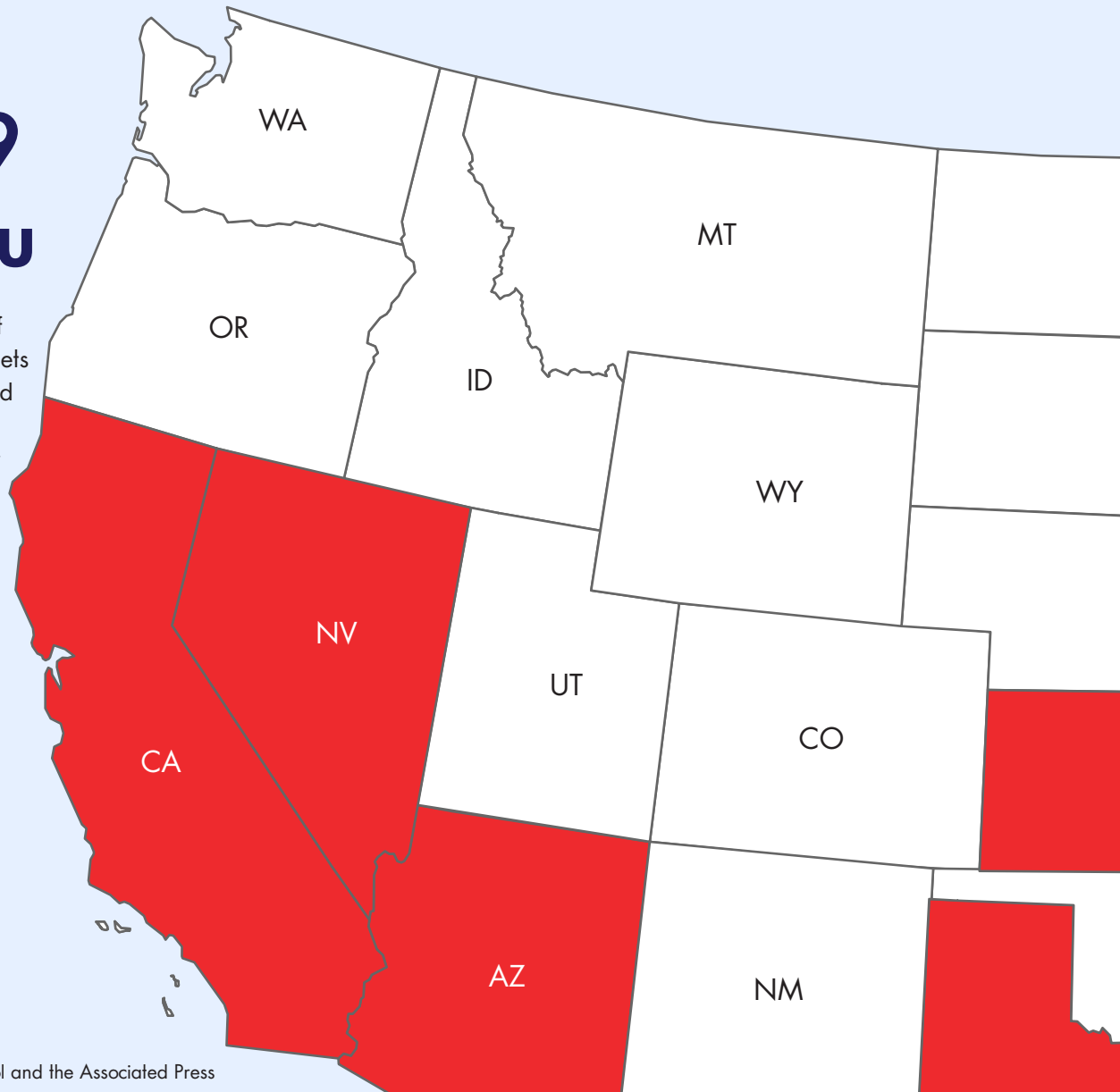


Tracking the 2009 Swine Flu

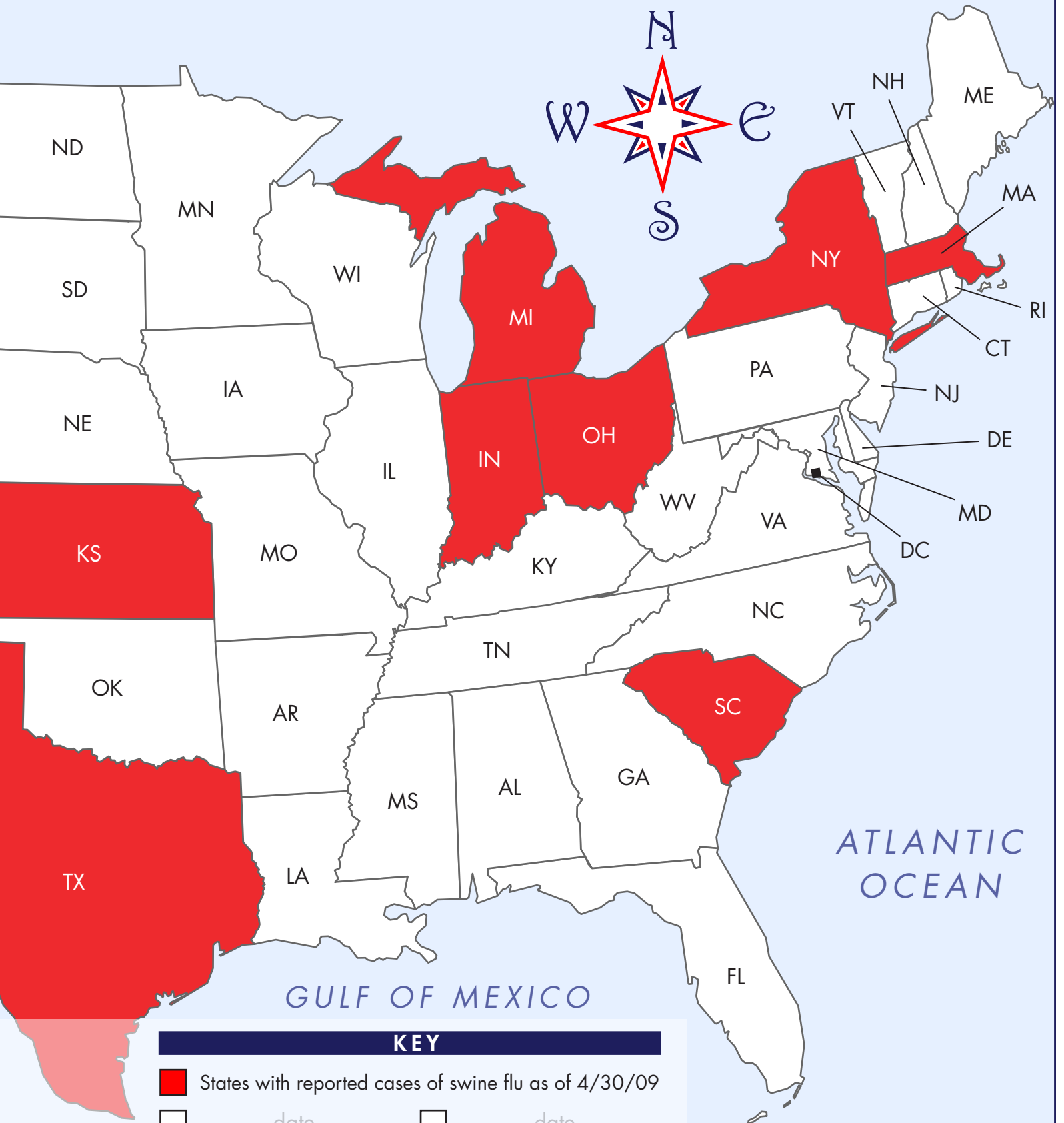
