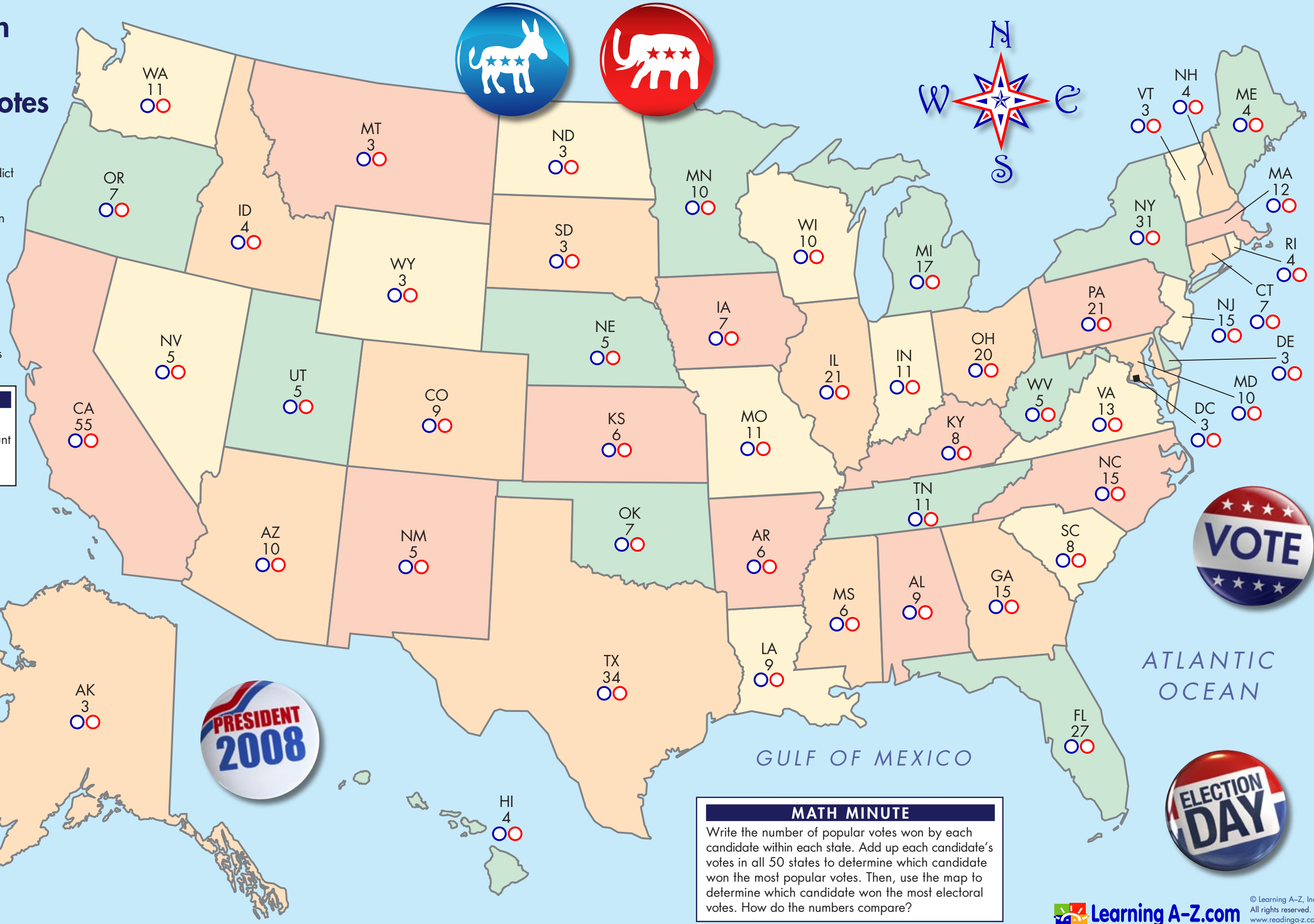


# Distribution of 2008 Electoral Votes
